Recent activity by the team

The quarterly ward panel meeting took place on 20th June, we discussed the ward promises we have addressed over the last 3 months which were 1. Speeding drivers – Operations have been undertaken targeting speeding drivers, those recorded driving in excess of the speed limit were reported for consideration for prosecution, 2. Motor vehicle crime prevention – We carried out more crime prevention stalls, delivered crime prevention leaflets around vehicle crime and used targeted patrols to deter criminals and reassure our residents, 3. Residential burglary prevention – Similar to vehicle crime prevention, we emphasise advice on burglary prevention more than any other subject, not to put fear into residents but to ensure we are all conscious and aware of what we can do to prevent burglary and protect our homes. The 3 promises for July, August & September are 1. Speeding drivers, 2. More high visibility foot & cycle patrols on the ward, 3. Promote OWL and recruit new members to ensure this helpful application is used to assist in the prevention of crime. OWL is very user friendly, please use it, and spread the word.

PC Martin has carried out arrest enquiries for a male living on the ward who is responsible for numerous thefts from Waitrose in Rickmansworth, it has recently come to light the same male is responsible for shoplifting in Waitrose, Green Lane, Officers will catch up with the male at some point. A new violent crime task force has been created to operate within the tri borough, I am happy to say we seldom see this task force on the ward, we are now required to carry out daily tasks such as, weapon sweeps, targeted patrols, knife surrender, School presentations & knife test purchases etc., carrying out these regular activities will help keep Northwood safe. PC's Martin & Bell carried out numerous high visibility patrols as well as plain clothes patrols when required, PCSO Usher also kept himself very busy on bicycle or foot patrol, he arranged 13 crime prevention stalls over the past 14 weeks, we believe these stalls have helped reduce crime on the ward.

Engagement Activities

Ward officers attended "Eid in the park" in June, we were made very welcome by all, and it was good to speak with those who reside in Northwood. Either Pc Bell or Pc Martin took part in each of the crime prevention stalls held over the past 13 weeks, we spoke with numerous residents about their concerns and provided crime prevention advice. We attended 5 care homes on the ward to offer personal safety advice and have a general chat with our senior residents, 2 of these homes were new to us, our presence appeared to be reassuring and advice was taken on-board. We held one or two 1 hour contact point sessions per week from Northwood Police Station in addition to the contact points held at Ruislip station. We also held "Coffee with copper" from Costa on Green Lane. It has been decided that we will no longer hold "Coffee with a copper", in future we will provide more contact points & crime prevention stalls. All of the engagements we arrange or attend each month are in addition to patrolling at every opportunity and preventing or investigating crime.
