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There is a lot of speeding in most roads where it is possible

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In my view a lot of burglaries are a very serious matter - they are an invasion of one's privacy, one's castle and can have long term effect. There is no blame attached to the victim of a burglary, whereas with a Robbery, it might be that I was in the wrong place at the wrong time. However there is a link with drugs, because the need for drugs fuel a lot of burglaries (not all, some are professional!)

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Would like to see focus on all crime and anti-social behaviour to feel even safer and comfortable when out and about in Northwood

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Particularly in Green Lane between Shops and Rickmansworth Road lights

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It is believed that the situation is being looked into but ACTION THIS DAY is needed.

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I see many drivers breaking the speed limit both through Northwood and especially along Green Lane, in both directions. Occasionally they can actually be very dangerous. I witnessed a car overtake a No. 282 stopped at the bus stop itself being overtaken by a No. 11 and then by a car overtaking both. This led to him (most probably it was a him) going over to the wrong side of the road and driving through the pedestrian crossing. A few more speed trapping events might be effective? Just a thought.

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Too much crime happening and no response from. Police.

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Theft of cars

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I am really worried about burglary. We have had a few dodgy people come round trying to sell us things - e.g. garden furniture so I think they may have been checking out the house.

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Burglary is a worry. Anxious when leaving the house unoccupied any time of day

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Anti-social behaviour: empty wine/spirit bottles and broken glass scattered along footpath, leading to steps and bridge over Northwood tube rail tracks (footpath in between Waitrose car park and synagogue on Murray road). This is a regular occurrence.

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Personally, other than confronting a couple of would-be shoplifters helping themselves to goods in Waitrose, I have not encountered any of the above crimes, so I would say that police should concentrate on whatever crimes they find to be prevalent in the area.

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There have been increased reports of burglary and theft it would be good to crack down on these if possible.

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Didn't even know VAWG existed in our area. We should collect a fund to give all women and girls pepper spray to keep in their handbags to attack back against these mofos.

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We have been victims of bullying and anti-social behaviour since last 7 years residing in Northwood and raise the voice to local council/police and neighbourhood police but none of them has helped us. We sent them video/ still recordings as well. We want justice to be done.

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I believe the Police have lost control because of lenient sentencing, which is not their fault The law breakers feel emboldened because of this, no real deterrent. Also many undesirables entering the country from various countries with organised crime and gangs. Again not the Police fault, so when they catch these people it's difficult to actually get them prosecuted. Then of course there aren't enough facilities to incarcerate these people

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We have reported drug dealing type activity in our vicinity to police at a community event. The same had been reported by our neighbours (same person, same activity), but this was not followed up with us, no crime report was made.

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All of the above are on the increase and affect all residents with seemingly little visible response from law enforcement.

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I do not know what the crime figures are for Burglary and Robbery but I am sure there is always a need to prioritise the use of illegal drugs, knife crime etc. as above.

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Burglary and Car Theft are becoming an increasingly bigger problem in Northwood.

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These instances happen more frequently than ever before.

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No problems

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The Police to take a much stronger and severe stance against shop lifting which seems to be rampant in Northwood particularly in Waitrose. My perception is that the shoplifters are confident that the police will not do anything and the staff for their own personal safety have to allow the shoplifters to have their way. Northwood is no longer the way it was with an increase in perceived antisocial behaviour.

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Theft from houses is always a worry. Youths seem to walk the streets with nothing to do. They shout loudly, drop litter and are generally anti-social. I have live here for 24 years and things are getting worse.

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I suppose all of the above are relevant, some less so in Northwood. I don't know the numbers of each in our area to comment properly.

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I consider knives as serious weapons and often people do not fully appreciate how dangerous and deadly their use can be.

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I don't think VAWG should be the priority, given the increasing number of burglaries happening in Northwood.

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All the above crimes are inter-related. It's a vicious cycle. Fighting the drugs trade is probably a good starting point.
